Dear residents, business owners,

VITAL is – as you know by now – in the process of building two split-level crossings at Kronenburg and Zonnestein. For this, a good number of cables and pipes has been relocated already. What remains, north of Kronenburg, is a water supply pipe for Waternet, underneath Beneluxbaan and the tracks.

VITAL is going to install a new pipe sleeve, to make sure the supply pipe will fit into the new local situation. At a later date, Waternet will use the pipe sleeve for installing a new supply pipe.

During the recent weekend works, a new pipe sleeve has already been installed underneath the tracks. In the upcoming period, this will also happen on either side of Beneluxbaan. With this letter I would like to inform you about this work, and how it may affect you.

The work in a nutshell

For the installation of the pipe sleeve underneath Beneluxbaan, tarmac will be removed, soil will be dug up, and foundations and reinforcements will be put in place. To be able to do this work, Beneluxbaan will be closed, first towards the north and subsequently towards the south. For that reason, the work will be done across two weekends. Unfortunately, noise and inconvenience for road users is inevitable. In addition, bus 55's itinerary will be shortened, temporarily.

Saturday 6 and Sunday 7 July: work at eastern side of Beneluxbaan

On Saturday 6 and Sunday 7 July VITAL will install a new pipe sleeve underneath the eastern lane of Beneluxbaan (in its current shape).

Consequences and inconvenience:

- On both days, VITAL will work between 7.00 and 23.00 hours.
- During this weekend the eastern lane of Beneluxbaan (towards the north) will be closed for motorised traffic between Kronenburg and Uilenstede. This will also be the case during the

- night from Saturday into Sunday. Local traffic towards Amsterdam will be diverted via Beneluxbaan, Saskia van Uylenburgweg, Prof. J.H. Bavincklaan and Uilenstede. Ongoing traffic will be diverted via Oranjebaan, Keizer Karelweg and Amstelveenseweg.
- During this weekend, bus 55 will be out of service between Amsterdam South station and the Oranjebaan stop. The buses follow an adjusted route, from Amstelveen's bus station via the Oranjebaan stop to the end stop, Sacharovlaan. Towards Amsterdam South station or southern Amstelveen, travellers can use tram 5 during this weekend.

Saturday 31 August and Sunday 1 September: work at western side of Beneluxbaan

On Saturday 31 August and Sunday 1 September VITAL will install a new pipe sleeve underneath the western lane of Beneluxbaan (in its current shape).

Consequences and inconvenience:

- On both days, VITAL will work between 7.00 and 23.00 hours.
- During this weekend the western lane of Beneluxbaan (towards the south) will be closed for motorised traffic between Kronenburg and Uilenstede. This will also be the case during the night from Saturday into Sunday. Local traffic from the north will be diverted via Beneluxbaan, Hoeksewaard and Eikenrodelaan. Ongoing traffic from the north will be diverted via Van Nijenrodeweg, Amstelveenseweg and Keizer Karelweg.
- During this weekend, bus 55 will be out of service between Amsterdam South station and the Oranjebaan stop. The buses follow an adjusted route, from Amstelveen's bus station via the Oranjebaan stop to the end stop, Sacharovlaan. Towards Amsterdam South station or southern Amstelveen, travellers can use tram 5 during this weekend.
